Announcement of Athabasca Pipeline Twinning Project

Enbridge Athabasca is proposing to develop a new crude oil pipeline project, called the Athabasca Pipeline Twinning Project to provide transportation service for increased oil production in the Kirby Lake area of Alberta. This project will include the construction of new pumping stations along the pipeline and the 345 km of additional pipeline from Kirby Lake to the Battle River Terminal at Hardisty, Alberta.

This project solidifies the importance of the Battle River Terminal at Hardisty and growing Hardisty into “ Alberta’s Oil Hub.”

This announcement coupled with the previous announcements by companies such as TransCanada Keystone Pipeline LP in regards to expansion of their interests in the Hardisty Terminal and increased pipeline capacity align the Town of Hardisty and surrounding region for continued growth and expansion as these facilities become the major oil hub in Alberta and Western Canada.

Council looks forward to the future expansion of the Hardisty Terminal and its partners as they continue to grow within this area of East Central Alberta. Hardisty is well positioned to take on new suppliers and service providers. Adequate highway commercial and serviced industrial property await development as well as residential development and businesses opportunities ready to accommodate those working in and for the ever expanding Hardisty Terminal.
