TOWN OF HARDISTY BYLAW NO. 1144/09

PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BYLAW BEING ENACTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE TOWN OF HARDISTY BYLAW NO. 1104/06, A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN OF HARDISTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TRAFFIC SAFETY ACT

WHEREAS Bylaw No. 1104/06 was passed for the purpose of regulating the use of off-highway vehicles within the Town of Hardisty.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Hardisty deems it necessary to amend Bylaw No. 1104/06 by changing the regulations:

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Hardisty, duly assembled, enacts the following:

1. Section 2:

Delete in its entirety and replace it to read as follows: "A person shall not operate an off-highway vehicle within the Town except on land owned by that person, or land owned by some other person with the consent of that other person, or with the written permission of the CAO to operate on public property."

2. Section 2.

Add bullet a) to read as follows "a) Without restricting the generality of the foregoing, the provisions of the Traffic Safety Act of Alberta shall apply to the operation of an off-highway vehicle allowed to operate on public property."

3. Section 2.

Add bullet b) to read as follows: "b) All off-highway vehicles allowed to operate on public property must be duly registered and insured pursuant to the Traffic Safety Act of Alberta."

4. Section 2.

Add bullet c) to read as follows: "c) A Peace Officer, employee or agent of the Town, may operate an off-highway vehicle on public property in connection with his duties."

5. Section 5.

Delete in its entirety and replace it to read as follows: "This Bylaw shall have force and take effect 60 calendar days following final reading thereof."

6. That Bylaw No. 1104/06 shall, in all other respects, remain the same.

This Bylaw shall have force and take effect 60 calendar days following final reading thereof.
