BYLAW 1148/09 TOWN OF HARDISTY

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HARDISTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMMEND THE PARKING BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HARDISTY BY

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act S.A. 2000, as amended ("the Act")

provides that a Municipal Council may amend its Parking Bylaw.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Hardisty wishes to amend the Parking

Bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Hardisty, duly assembled, enacts as

follows:

1. Bylaw No. 1124/08, the Parking Bylaw of the Town of Hardisty, is hereby amended as follows:

- A. Add to Section 4, subsection g) as below:
- (g) One parking stall shall be defined as handicap parking on 51 Avenue on the northwest corner of the intersection of 51 Avenue and 49 street. This stall shall be defined by a handicap parking sign and painted curb and roadway symbol.

This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon receiving third reading.
