Public Works Info, Tips and Tricks - Submitted by Brian Harrison

Hello Everyone!

This is the first edition of the Info, Tips and Tricks from the public works department designed to provide information to inform, educate and provide insight on why certain tasks are completed the way they are due to costs, regulations, or even liability issues from a public works perspective.

So, for the first issue, some friendly reminders to homeowner's, renters, and landlords:

- DO keep and unobstructed and clean access to water meters and main shut off valves. Meters will require service and replacement from time to time and shut off valves will need to be accessible in case of an emergency.
- DO exercise (on/off/on) your main shut off valve a minimum of once a year. If it is an older style gate valve or globe valve, consider replacing it with a ball valve next time a plumber is in doing repairs. This valve is the most important piece of plumbing in your house or mobile home.
- DO NOT pour cooking oil or grease directly into a drain, sink or toilet as it will cause major problems eventually. Dispose of in a heatproof container like a used pickle jar or non-plastic container and dispose of into your regular garbage.
- DO NOT dispose of diapers, wipes, feminine hygiene products etc. into toilets; even if they say they are "flushable." Please dispose in the trash.

As a homeowner, you are responsible for the sewer line from inside your swelling to the "main line" where it joins the sewer out in the street. When contacted, we will determine if the main line is blocked or obstructed and will clear it if necessary. If it is determined to be a local property issue, you will be required to contact qualified tradespeople to "fix" the issue at your cost.

Next issue we will try to cover relevant seasonal questions.


