# OUR INTENT:


Inspired by the 100 Women Who Care movement in the USA, a group of women decided to bring the idea to Flagstaff County.
Our goal is simple: Bring together 100-plus women in Flagstaff County who care about local community causes and are committed to charitable service.
Four times a year, we meet for an entertaining evening and jointly vote for a local organization. Three candidates are nominated ahead of time. Each woman or team of women write a \$100 cheque, receives her voting ballot and watches how her \$100 donation to the winning organization along with the rest of the group's commitment turns into a \$10,000 or more donation for one local organization.
With four meetings a year and 100% honored pledges, we can witness how \$40,000 or more can improve the

lives of our neighbours when placed in the hands of deserving organizations working to serve the Flagstaff Region. In just 3 years, our organization has donated 145,000 to deserving groups in the Flagstaff region! Astounding!

Our organizing committee includes the following ladies from the Flagstaff Region: Holly Bovencamp, Tanya Piche and Joanne McMahon. Our first meeting of our fourth year will be held on October 18, 2022 in person at the Hardisty Community Hall. 
