Hello friends and neighbors,

I hope this letter finds you well. Recently, our community has had some big wins! Admittedly, some of them are long overdue, but it's great to see things coming together. I will touch on a few of our recent successes.

The Irma School Bus Group secured funding for the 2023/2024 school year. Buffalo Trail Public Schools agreed to pay transportation costs to the school division line. Hardisty families agreed to pay the remaining fraction of the cost to keep the bus coming to town. There are approximately forty children that ride the bus direct to Irma School and back. been working very well as an alternative. I have visited Irma, Sedgewick, and Amisk Schools. They are all excellent schools with great staff and programs.

The Town of Hardisty established a lease agreement with GCS Energy Services to keep Hardisty Airport operational. This agreement allows us to continue providing airport services to our local businesses and industry neighbors with minimal cost to resident taxpayers. I would like to thank GCS Energy Services for collaborating with the Town of Hardisty.

Work on the 48th Street access to highway 13 project is complete. This road will relieve traffic pressure at the highway 881 and 13 intersection and give travelers an alternate route in emergency situations. We also believe this road will promote growth for the highway front development area.

We have worked hard to revisit and establish updated working agreements with The Hardisty Golf Course, Hardisty Hall board, Hardisty Rodeo Association, and Hardisty Ag Society (arena, curling rink, and campsites). All parties have signed off on the updated agreements. It was great to get these wrapped up. I would like to thank all the associations and our administration team for their hard work on these matters.

We have seen a dramatic increase in property sales and rentals lately. There have also been numerous inquiries about town-owned lots. Our professional building has multiple tenants, and several new businesses have opened in town. Ma N Pa's restaurant, MacRae Farm and Ranch Supply, Willowtree Children's Society, and Bird Dog Theatre Co. My apologies if I've missed anyone. The Council has been incredibly pleased to see new families and businesses wanting to call Hardisty their home.


I saved the best for last. As I'm sure you've heard, The Hardisty Hospital Emergency Department has reopened. Man, that feels good to say! The ER has been closed since April of 2020. Hardisty Council, The District Development Group, MLA Lovely, Community Members, Dr. Ivare, and The Hardisty Terminal Group kept the pressure on and never gave up. By banding together and being relentless, the doors are finally open. Currently, the ER will have limited operating hours. It's a great start and I know if we all keep working together, we can get our ER back to the 24hr service it should be. AHS will be having a grand reopening celebration for the public sometime in October.

These are some key points I wanted to share, your Hardisty Town Council, Administration and Public Works staff have many projects and initiatives on the go. 








October 25: Farmer Stress and Coping in Alberta

This interactive webinar describes the recent research findings from the Farmer Stress, Coping and Resilience Study completed by over 350 Albertan farmers.
