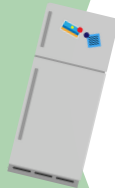

<p>Title: Recreation Grant</p> <p>Policy No: 1701 Effective Date: Jan 1/2024 Reviewed: Jan 1/2020</p> <p>Supersedes Policy No:</p>	
<p>Policy Statement: The Hardisty Agricultural Society supports recreation facilities & groups through grant funding provided by Hardisty Ag Society and/or Flagstaff County.</p>	
<p>Purpose: To provide recreation and community services through enabling and supporting viable Town of Hardisty organizations, groups or agencies.</p>	
<p>Principles</p>	

1. Organizations and/or their facilities must be located within the geographical boundaries of the Town of Hardisty and not owned or operated by another municipality.
2. **The organization must be a registered non-profit group** that is in good standing with Corporate Affairs or be a known and recognized non-profit group that files annually audited financial statements. **A copy of the financial statement must be provided with the application.**
3. Recreation Grant applications for funding must use the attached form and are to be completed by **May 31/2024**
4. Funding provided will be dependent on funding availability and criteria as set by the Ag Society.
5. Funds received must be for recreation, community facilities or the operation of them, which are open for the use and enjoyment of the whole community.
6. Funds are not permitted for cemeteries, churches, museums or business associations.
7. Applicants can only receive one grant per calendar year.
